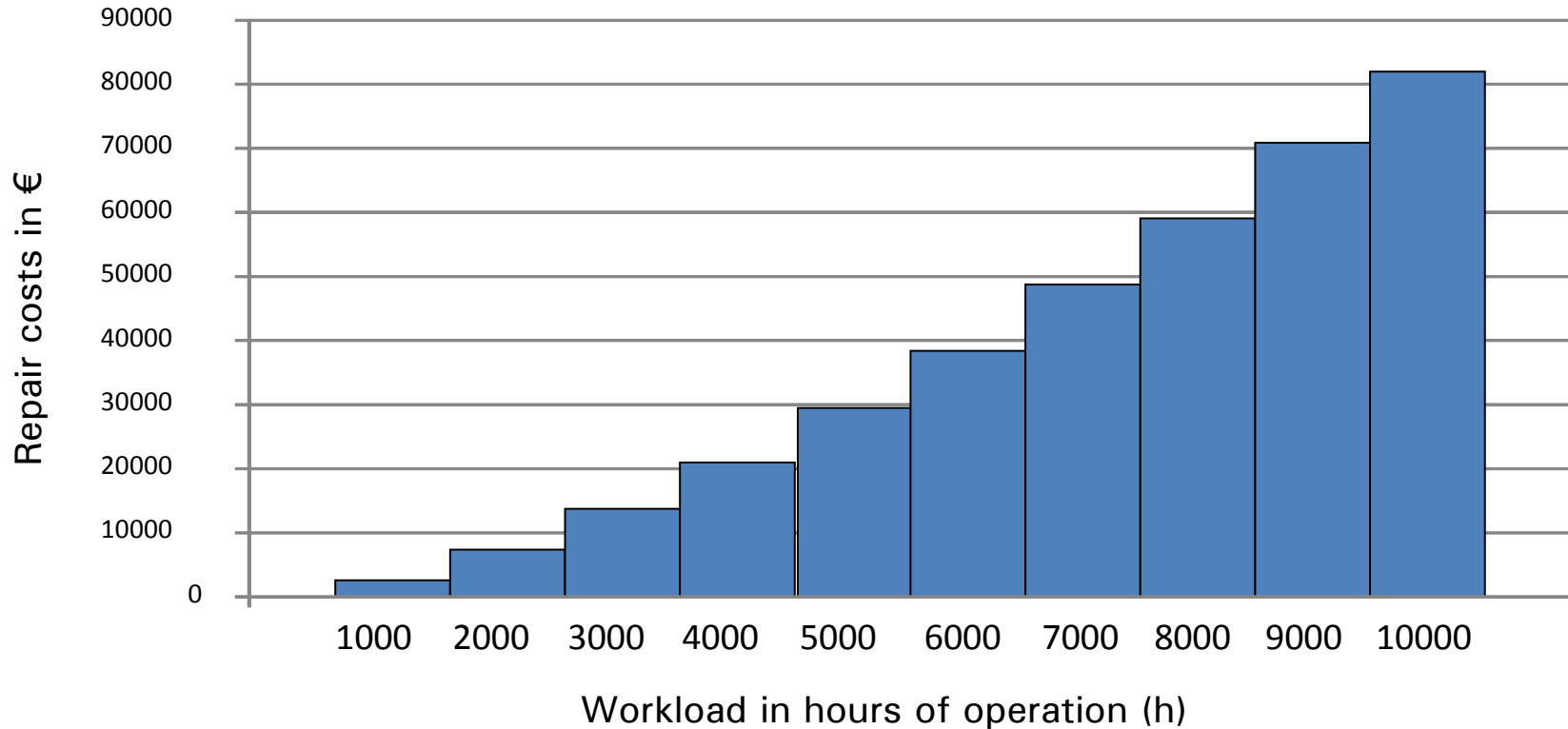
Repair costs

In general, repairs are considered the act in which a defective object is brought back to its original, functioning state. This includes the replacement and the restoration of worn parts.

- » Wear parts
 - » Engine
 - » Transmission
 - » Electric
- » Tire replacement
- » Windows, mirrors
- » Etc.

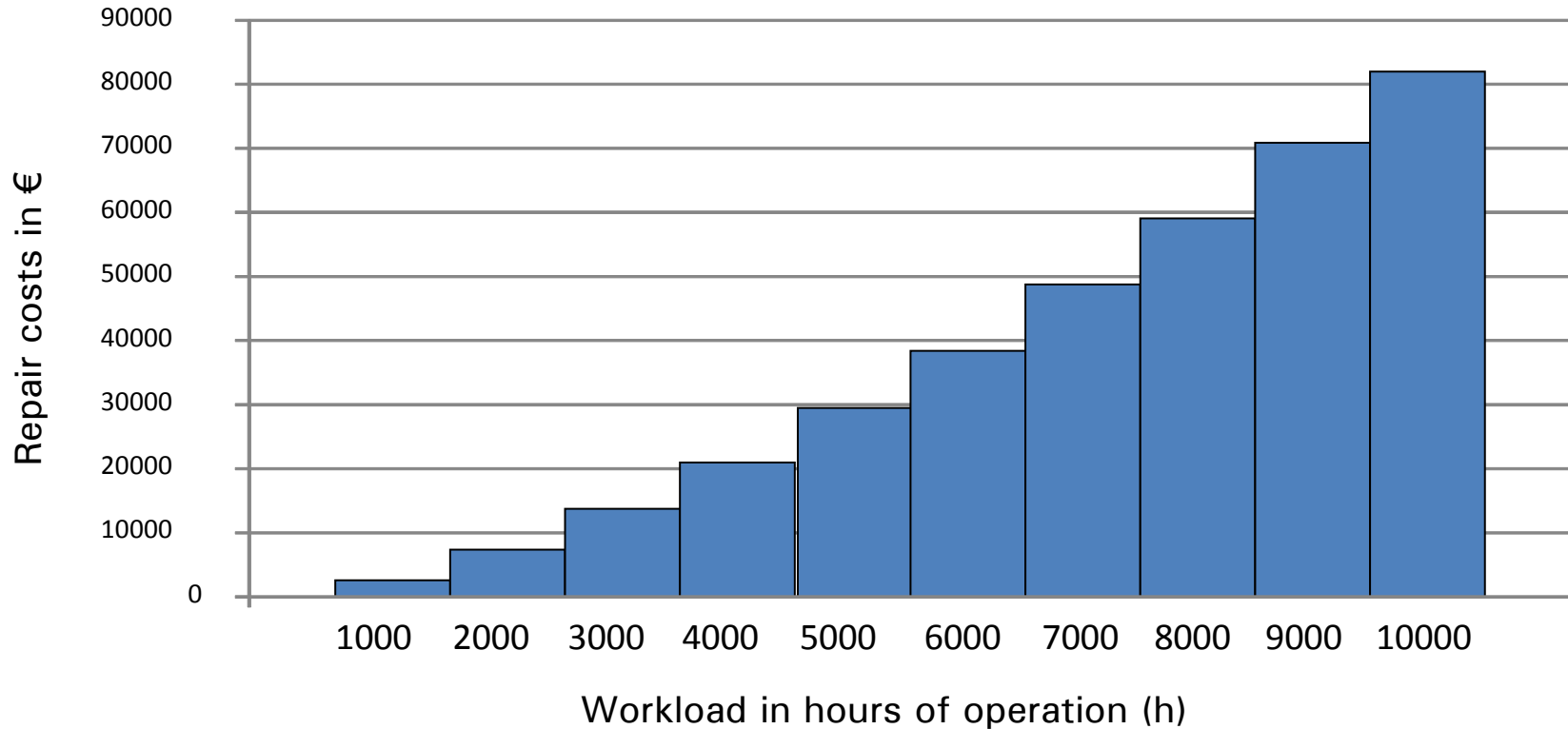

$$8,20 \text{ €/h} * 1,29 = \mathbf{10,58 \text{ €/h}}$$
